Our Images for St. Anne's

Pictures and images have become an important part of our life at St. Anne's. Over the past months, we have featured many wonderful pictures in the *Ministry Highlights*. Pictures have helped us to know each other's names. We see the evident pride when your picture is included. Our photographers have learned and grown in their skills and are performing a great ministry for St. Anne's.

We are now in the process of renewing the church website and we would like to include some of our best photographs. Pictures celebrate St. Anne's as a wonderful community, and we want the world to know what we're up to. However, since the web is worldwide, to do this we need written permission to use your image. We have adapted the "Image Release Form" from the ones used by the Toronto District School Board (TDSB and Girl Guides Canada. These will be familiar to many parents in our community as they are signed each year.

How would we use your image?

- We will include pictures of you, especially to show our values and tell about our events.
- We want to use pictures to show our community and all of us at our best.
- We will not use pictures that are inappropriate or demeaning, and we will respond immediately if you have a concern about any specific image.
- We will identify by full name only those in official ministry roles. All others will be identified first name only.
- We want each of you to be proud of our church.

What we will do with your signed *Image Release*:

- We will keep your signed *Image Release* on file
- If you do not wish to give permission, please indicate this on the form. For future photography/recording occasions:
 - You may prefer to step aside when a photograph or video is being made.
 - Assigned photographers would take pictures of everyone present (the onus is not on the photographer to memorize the Image Release list). Before publication, we will refer to our file to know whose image must not be included.

What are the possibilities? Imagine:

- We are filming this year's Christmas Pageant. What if next year, we are able to convince CBC to show a portion of it on television in advance of next year's pageant? We would need your permission.
- Imagine that by next year, we want to put an advertisement in a newspaper or in *Wholenote* – using a great photo we have taken with people in it. We would need permission of the people in the picture.
- Imagine we wanted to record our whole Easter service and put it on Youtube. We would need permission from those whose faces are recognizable.
